# Crime in New York State 2023 Final Data

New York State and the FBI use seven Index crime categories as indicators of overall crime trends: murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault, which are classified as violent crimes, and the property crimes of burglary, larceny and motor vehicle theft. The FBI created these categories to allow for uniform crime reporting across all 50 states. Police departments and sheriffs' offices report Index crime to the Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) through the Uniform Crime Reporting and Incident-Based Reporting programs. This report details 2023 Index crime trends in New York State, its two regions (New York City and Non-New York City, the 57 counties outside of the five boroughs), and each of the 62 counties. This report also details Index crime rates per 100,000 population statewide and by county and region. DCJS uses county population data from the FBI, which is based on U.S. Census estimates, to calculate crime rates.

New York State implemented the FBI's expanded definition of rape in 2015; this resulted in an uptick in violent crime and reported rapes in that year compared to prior years. As a result, caution should be used when citing or interpreting any percentage changes between rapes reported in 2015 and any subsequent year, to those reported in 2014 and earlier.

The FBI made the change to more accurately reflect the scope and volume of sexual assaults nationwide. Before the implementation, those offenses would have been classified by the FBI and state as Part II sex offenses.


This report compares Index and violent crime over the 10-year period from 2014 through 2023, but it <u>does not</u> include percentage change comparisons between rape statistics reported in 2023 to 2014 statistics because of the expanded definition.

Index crime volume in New York State increased 4 percent in 2023 compared to 2022, with 440,305 Index crimes reported. This was driven by a 7 percent increase in property crimes, resulting from a significant spike in motor vehicle theft (+43%) and increase in larceny (+5%). All four violent crime categories decreased, with the largest declines in murder (-15%) and assault (-8%).

The state's index crime rate increased by 8 percent when comparing 2014 and 2023. During this period, the violent crime rate rose by 10 percent and there was a 7 percent increase in firearm-related homicides (see page 4 for additional details). These increases mirrored national trends.


### Percentage Change in Crime Volume 2022 vs. 2023




### Change in Crime Volume: 2014 vs. 2023

Index crime decreased steadily for five consecutive years beginning in 2014 and reached historic lows in 2019. Crime levels remained stable through 2020 and 2021 before increasing sharply in 2022, and by 4 percent when comparing that year to 2023.

In comparison to 2014, there were 30,101 more crimes reported statewide (+7%) in 2023.




### Regional Trends in Crime: 2014 to 2023



Comparing Index crimes in 2023 to 2014 in the state's two regions, reported crime in Non-New York City decreased by 32,911 crimes (-15%), while New York City saw an increase of 63,012 crimes (+34%) reported.

In 2023, total crime volume in Non-New York City was lower than New York City for the fifth year in a row.



While reported violent crime remained stable in Non-New York City, the five boroughs experienced a 13 percent increase in violent crime in 2023 compared to 2014 despite a decreasing in 2023 as compared to 2022.

As noted, the state's implementation of the FBI's expanded definition of rape resulted in an increase in violent crime in both regions from 2014 to 2015. This change resulted in 3,162 additional crimes being classified as rape in 2023; prior to the change, those offenses would have been classified by the FBI and state as Part II sex offenses.


#### Statewide Crime Trends: 2022 vs. 2023

The number of Index crimes reported in New York State increased by 4 percent in 2023 compared to the previous year.


Violent crime decreased by 7 percent with decreases in all violent categories: murder (-15%), aggravated assault (-8%), rape (-6%) and robbery (-5%).

Property crime increased by 7 percent, with increases in motor vehicle theft (+43%) and larceny (+5%). Motor vehicle theft comprised 11 percent of all property crimes reported in 2023. Burglary decreased (-5%).

#### **New York City**

Index crimes rose 4 percent in 2023 versus 2022, driven by a 9 percent increase in property crime. Violent crime declined 9 percent.

All four violent crime categories decreased compared to the previous year: aggravated assault (-11%), murder (-8%), robbery (-5%), and rape (-2%).

The increase in property crime is attributable to a spike in motor vehicle theft (+28%). Larceny crime also rose 9 percent, while burglary decreased 6 percent.

#### **Non-New York City**

Index crimes increased 3 percent in 2023 compared to 2022 due to a 4 percent increase in property crime that was driven solely by a 59 percent increase in motor vehicle thefts. Burglary decreased (-4%) and larceny counts were stable.


Violent crime decreased 4 percent, with decreases in murder (-24%), rape (-10%), robbery (-4%) and aggravated assault (-2%). Appendix 3 lists crime rates by county for 2023



### Regional Trends in Violent Crime by Firearm: 2019 vs. 2023

In New York City, the number of violent crimes involving firearms increased when comparing 2023 to 2019 (6,697 vs. 4,305). There was a 26 percent decrease in 2023 compared to 2022, when 9,062 crimes by firearm were reported.

Violent crimes involving a firearm outside of New York City increased 18 percent in 2023 as compared to 2019 (4,257 vs. 3,607). In 2023, there was a 13 percent decrease in violent crimes by firearm compared to 2022 (4,257 vs. 4,872). See Appendix 4 for more details.





### Regional Trends in Homicide: 2014 through 2023

In 2023, total homicides and firearm-related homicides in New York State decreased for the second year in a row. Statewide, there were 669 homicides, a 15 percent decrease compared to 2022.

Homicides and other index crimes reported annually from 2000 through 2023 are available online.

Reported homicides in New York City decreased 8 percent (402 vs. 438) and declined 24 percent (267 vs. 353) in Non-New York City. When comparing 2023 to 2014, homicides statewide increased 9 percent (669 vs. 616).

Regionally, homicides increased 21 percent (402 vs. 333) in New York City and decreased nearly 6 percent (267 vs. 283) in Non-New York City when comparing 2023 to 2014.
